4) Craft – Qualities-of-God Flip Books



Supplies:

- Index Cards
- Colored Paper
- Crayons or Markers
- Tape

Directions:

1. On the blank side of one index card, have your child write the word “Holy” in the middle of the card, and then have them write “Revelation 4:8” on the lower right corner. This is the front of the card, and so your child can decorate it to represent the quality of holiness.
2. On the back of the card, have your child write the verse.
3. On a piece of colored paper write or have the kids write, “God is...”



4. Let them tape down the index card next to the phrase, in order to complete the sentence. Each week we will be adding another character trait to their flip-book.

5) Learning Activity – What Do We Lack?

If you've been following the adult messages on Sunday mornings, you know we're in a series studying James. This goes along perfectly with the call that we are to be holy because God is holy! So, I encourage you to share with your kids some ways that God is calling you to be holy in your actions, attitudes and/or words.

In James, the Bible tells us that God tests our faith so that we may be "mature and complete, not lacking anything." James 1:2-4. And James goes on to say that when we do lack something, we should ask God for what we are lacking.

This week's lesson is about God's holiness. And our response to a holy God should be seen in our attitudes in worshiping God and in how we live. This week, take time to talk to your kids about ways in which *your family* may not really be living or worshiping in a way that is set apart for God (or holy). Then, rather than trying to fix those areas on your own, come together as a family every day this week and ask God to fill in those areas that you lack. For example, if you and your family conclude you are not hospitable to outsiders, come together as a family and let God know you see this area lacking in your family, and ask Him to change your family to make you more hospitable to outsiders.

The goal is to lead your kids to recognize their own sin next to God's standards, and then present those areas that fall short to Him so that He can change their hearts, desires, and ultimately their actions.
