BIBLE BASIS: Psalm 22, John 14:16 & Acts 17:10-11

KEY VERSE: "Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No

one comes to the Father except through me." - John 14:16

4) Craft – Qualities-of-God Flip Books (Continued)



Supplies:

- Index Cards
- Colored Paper
- Crayons or Markers
- Tape

Directions:

- 1. On the blank side of one index card, have your child write the word "Holy" in the middle of the card, and then have them write "Revelation 4:8" on the lower right corner. This is the front of the card, and so your child can decorate it to represent the quality of holiness.
- 2. On the back of the card, have your child write the verse.
- 3. On a piece of colored paper write or have the kids write, "God is..."
- 4. Let them tape down the index card next to the phrase, in order to complete the sentence. Each week we will be adding another character trait to their flip-book. This week we will add the word "Truth" or "Trustworthy"

5) Learning Activity - Making a Compass (Parents will need to help with this project)





Supplies:

- Metal sewing needle
- A magnet (It can be a flat refrigerator magnet or a more powerful magnet. A stronger magnet will work best.)
- A pair of pliers
- A cork
- Scissors for cutting the cork
- a wide cup, drinking glass or bowl
- Water

Directions:

- Rub the magnet against the sewing needle at least five times. (If you are using a
 weaker magnet, such as a flat refrigerator magnet, rub the needle at least a dozen
 times.) Always rub the magnet in the same direction against the needle. Your needle
 should now be magnetized.
- 2. Now cut off about one quarter inch of the cork from one of the ends, making a small cork disk that is about one-quarter-inch tall.
- 3. Laying the cork disk on a flat surface, carefully push the needle through the side of the disk by using the pair of pliers. Push the needle all the way through the disk so that about the same amount of needle shows on either side of the disk.
- 4. Fill a wide cup, drinking glass or bowl with at least one inch of water.
- 5. Put the cork disk (with the needle) on the water in the cup. Try to keep the disk floating in the center of the water, away from the sides of the cup. What does the needle do? When it stops moving, what direction does it point toward?
- 6. Find out what direction north is in your location. Did your needle point in that direction? (You can use a real compass, an atlas or smartphone map for this.)

<u>Tie In</u>: A compass points us to a fixed point – North. When we have a fixed point, we do not have to worry about getting lost. Similarly, God's word is our fixed point – He is the truth. When we follow God's, we do not have to worry about getting lost.
